A nomination form is available to download on the European Chamber website.

Nominations should be made clearly and should specify the name of the candidates, the position for which they are offering themselves, the company they represent and a declaration that the company is a member of the European Chamber.

The nomination form should also bear the signatures of a nominator and a seconder, who must be members of the Sectoral Working Groups in good standing.

I attach a copy of Articles 7 and 10 of the Articles of Association and of By-laws No.1 "Electoral Standing Orders", which outline in detail the eligibility to vote, to nominate and stand as a candidate, as well as the procedure for nomination and for the conduct of the election.
